

Driver's Education 2021 Summer Class

Dear Parent/ Guardian:

We are very excited to announce that we will be offering a Driver's Education Summer class. We will teach a class the at Albany High School from May 3 through May 14, 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM. The cost of this class is \$400.00.

You may pay by **ONLINE, CASH, CHECK, or MONEY ORDER ONLY at the student's school.** If paying by check, it must include two phone numbers.

Payment and registration needs to be completed in the front office by Friday, April 30. In order to participate in this program, **students must turn 15 years of age by July 1, 2021,** and be enrolled in school.

Classes will be held at Albany High School.

Classroom # will be determined, but will be consistent with social distancing guidelines.

Driving times will be determined during the classroom phase and accomplished over the Summer Break.

Since **students will receive a ½ credit towards graduation & grade will go towards GPA,** they are required to attend all classes; absences or tardiness could constitute no credit without refund. Students must wear school uniform during the classroom phase, and adhere to all dress code regulations as described by LPSB. A one subject notebook, pen/ pencil, and highlighter will be needed. Notice to all students signing up for Driver's Education

The state of Louisiana has instituted a new procedure for those who are enrolling in a Driver's Education program to obtain a learner's permit. Each applicant is now required to obtain a Temporary Instructional Permit (TIP) from the Louisiana Department of Motor Vehicles prior to being allowed to complete the required 38 hour program.

Though students are able to enroll in the program before obtaining the TIP, no student will receive a scheduled time to drive or be able to take the class final test without physical verification of the TIP by the instructor.

For your convenience, I have listed what to bring to the Office of Motor Vehicles to obtain a Temporary Instructional Permit for Driver's Education:

Minor Students (14 years to 17 years old)

- * Original or State Certified Birth Certificate (no photocopies) and another primary document or two secondary forms of identification.
- * Social Security Card
- * School Enrollment Form – student must be at least in the 8th grade
- * Original or Court Certified Custody Papers (if there are any)
- * Legal Custodial/Domiciliary Parent/Guardian with their Driver's License or State ID Card

After completion of the 30 hour classroom instruction, students will be given a driving appointment agreed upon by the student and instructor. After that date is set, there will be a \$50 fee for any schedule changes to offset the costs associated with the extended usage of the instructional vehicle created by rescheduling for reasons other than a medical emergency. No refunds will be made for students who attend the classroom portion but are unable to drive due to failure to obtain the TIP.

The Livingston Parish School Board's Driver's Education program is committed to providing an excellent educational and driving experience at a competitive cost. As a partner to this program, Gateway Ford of Ponchatoula leases new vehicles to the program based on the schedules submitted by the instructors. Due to the issues created for the instructors and our leasing partner, a fee of \$25 (twenty-five dollars) will be assessed for any schedule changes requested by or on behalf of the student driver after the schedule is set and agreed upon in the class by the instructor and the student, with the only exception being for a medical emergency. A \$50 fee (fifty dollars) will be assessed for any student who fails to arrive on an appointed day without contacting the instructor.
